BUSES / DROP OFF

Your bus will drop you off outside this entrance way and you will also line up here after school if you need to catch a bus home. For details on individual bus routes, parents are requested to contact the School Office: 6425 0999.

Bus services are available from most areas.

CARE GROUP

If you have classes at the start of the day, you go to Care Group to do attendance, listen to any notices, and enjoy a Bible Devotion together. Your Care Teacher and Coordinator are there to help you with questions about the day that you might have.

Your lockers are usually located in or near the Common Room.

TIMETABLE

At the start of the year, you will be given a timetable to follow, that will tell you when your subjects are on and where the classroom is. It will also tell you when your Study Lines are. There is time at the start of the year where you can modify your subjects as you settle in.

CANTEEN / LUNCH ORDERS

The Canteen is open on Wed - Thur - Fri.

In High School you may access the Canteen at recess and lunchtime to purchase food or drinks. You may also place an order via the Qkr app.

LUNCH AND RECESS AREAS

In Year 11/12, you have access to the recently refurbished Common Room and an Outdoor Table Tennis table in the Heritage Garden area.

Once the Co-ordinator has approved your sign out privileges, you can also go off-site.

The Hub and Library are also open at recess and lunchtime.

YEAR 11/12 CAMP

Each year the students are invited to an Orientation camp at Camp Clayton for one night. This is a great way to make new friends, get to know your teachers and spend time together as a Year group.

HOUSE TEAM AND COLOUR

You will be told at the beginning of the year which house team you are in. If you attended Leighland Christian School in Primary, you will be in the same house. If you have siblings at the School, you will be put in the same house as them. The School houses are:

IF I HAVE A PROBLEM

If you would like to speak to someone about an issue you are having, please approach your Care teacher first and then the 11/12 Coordinator. If it is relation to your subject, talking to your subject teacher is the place to start.

PAYMENT OPTIONS

Leighland Christian School provides a number of fee payment options. Fee policies exist to ensure Christian education is not outside the reach of families. Our Fee payment options include using electronic transfer arrangements via Direct Debit, BPAY, Centrepay, QKR or EFTPOS. Fee Discounts apply for parents who pay their full fees in advance each year. This incentive will attract a 5% discount if the entire year is paid before Term 1 commences.

WHAT DO FEES INCLUDE?

School fees are inclusive of all books and stationery and cover most other educational expenses except uniform, the occasional Home Ec items and some Year 11 & 12 subjects. This means there are no hidden education costs allowing parents to budget effectively.

FAMILY DISCOUNTS

Family discounts apply for the second and third child and there is no charge for the fourth child onwards. This keeps fees affordable for larger families. Costs associated with travel or interstate excursions are not automatically included in fees. Sibling discounts apply for the second (50%), third (65%) and fourth child (100%).


