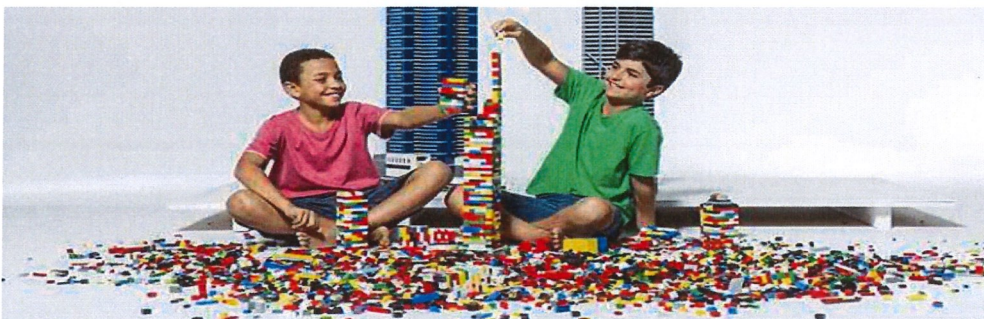


# CONGRATULATIONS

## QKR

### **QKR Android Phone Issue Checklist**

Some people have reported issues using QKR on android devices. QKR tech support have provided the following checklist and has successfully resolved the issue by using the following, with particular note to the last two steps in the following list.

Please check the following:

1. Is this device running a custom Android version?
2. Did you download Qkr from the Google Play Store or from some other marketplace?
3. Is this phone “rooted”? ROOTED means that you have set the phone up in a non-android legal way.
4. Are the Google Play Services installed on the device?
5. Is the device connected to a VPN?
6. If Google Chrome is installed on this device, uninstall Google Chrome and try to run Qkr again (without having Google Chrome installed).
7. If point 6 fails, reinstall Google Chrome (latest version), make sure that the device has the latest Google Play Services installed, and try Qkr again.
